



VII MEDITERRANEAN XTREM Technical File v1

Introduction

The **Mediterranean XTREM** is a Cycling For All BTT event.

It is an individual (solo) event. The event will take place from **Friday 15th to Sunday 17th of OCTOBER 2021** in Vilareal, Montanejos and Benicassim (Province of Castellón – Spain)

The event follows the article 9 of the RFEC (Real Federación Española de Ciclismo) and the UCI (International Cycling Union) technical and sport regulations for Cycling For All.

Registration

Any person who wishes to take part in this competition must register through the official website: www.medxtrem.es

The competition is open to any cyclist over 18 years and offers single and Team-of-two participation options.

The registration period will begin on May 2021 and end on October 2021 or until the slots available are completed (500).

The entry fee per participant is 230EUR:

Besides the aforementioned price, cyclists that don't have a valid license by the RFEC shall have to pay an additional 10€/day for the participant's insurance.

Registration will include:

- On-line customer service.
- Right to take part in the event.
- Personalized plate and start number.
- Route profile stickers.
- Registration gifts.

- Finisher gift (if achieved).
 - Electronic timing
 - Course marking and marshals.
 - Sweep vehicles.
 - Liquid and solid feed zones

- Medical assistance on and off the course.
 - Bicycle washing area.
 - Guarded bicycle parking.
 - Cloakroom.
 - Changing rooms, toilets and showers.
 - Other free services at the paddock.

Administrative checks

The administrative checks and Welcome Pack pick-up will take place on **Thursday 14th of October 2021**. During the administrative checks an identification bracelet is handed out to each participant, who has to wear it during all the competition. This bracelet allows access to the participant areas and is also useful for safety measures.

Route

The final tracks of the 3 stages are still being defined. The planed routes will be aprox

STAGE 1 – Vilareal-Montanejos 110km 3.000m+

STAGE 2 – Montanejos – Montanejos 90km 2.800m+

STAGE 3 – Montanejos – Benicassim 120km 2.900m+

**More detailed information about the route tracks will be provided later in future versions of this document.*

The event is a navigation based race, and the use of GPS is mandatory. The route will be only marked with signs at trouble spots, such as cross sections, road crossings or streets.

Feed and tech zones

Feed and aid zones are properly sign posted all throughout the route every 25-30km. These will have everything necessary to cover the participants' food and hydration needs during the competition.

Safety

The race will be covered by a good number of medical assistance units (ambulances, doctors, 4x4 Rescue Car,...)

There will also be a Medical Tent at the Finish line facilities

The organization will have several support vehicles to drive back those riders, that due to mechanical or health problems aren't able to finish the stage. We will take care of riders and bikes and bring them to the paddock area.

The reference Hospital will be the HOSPITAL JAIME I in Castellón (aprox 20km from Oropesa del Mar)

Event Location

The event will take place in 3 different venues: Vilareal, Montanejos and Benicassim.

All of them will all services needed to be a host of a MTB

There are 4 airports to which riders might flight to get to Oropesa del Mar:

Castellón Airport – 25 min. drive from Oropesa– limited airlines

Valencia Airport -1hour drive from Oropesa

Reus Airport – 1,5h drive from Oropesa – mainly LowCost airlines

Barcelona Airport – 2hour drive from Oropesa
