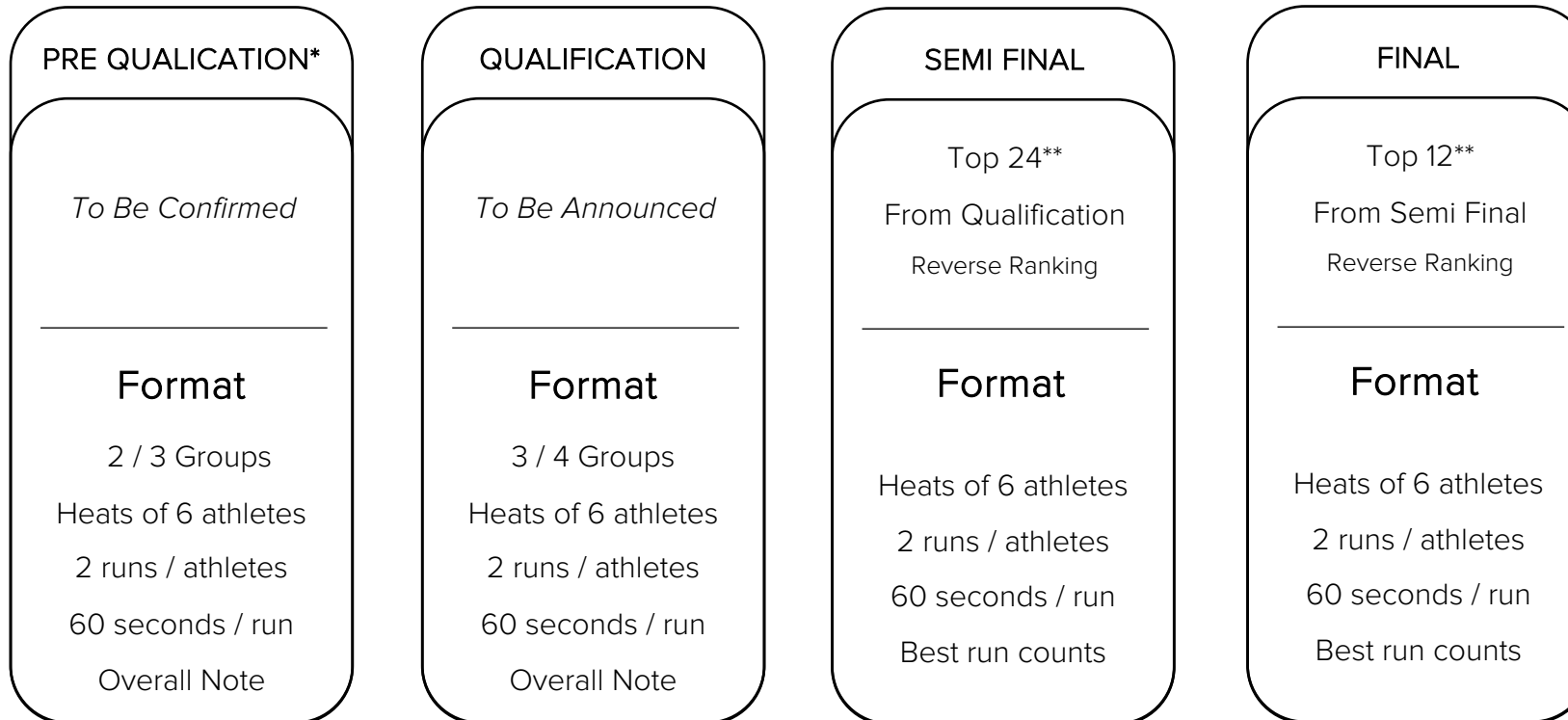

COMPETITION FORMAT



The FISE World Series as part of the UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup follows the rules as defined by the UCI. Please refer to the UCI Rules Book for any question regarding the competition format.

* A valid UCI cycling licence is required to be part of the competition

** If less than 31 athletes registered then the semi final will not take place and the top 12 from Qualification will be advanced to Final.

In case of a canceled phase, the results from the last phase will be considered as final results.*

JUDGING CRITERIA

The performance of each rider is judged on overall impression including, but not limited to :

- Difficulty (refers to not only the tricks performed but also the placement of the tricks within the course and the combinations used),
- Height (amplitude of the tricks performed),
- Flow,
- Originality (tricks and lines) and versatility,
- Style,
- Progression,
- Variety of tricks (refers to a good mix of standard airs, rotations, grinds, ...),
- Risk factor,
- Landings,
- Use of the course,
- Execution.

The overall composition of the runs is most important as the judges evaluate the sequences of tricks, the amount of risk in the routine, and how the rider uses the course. The judges take errors such as falls and stops into consideration.

- Results

The results of the competition will be published on the FISE Website within an hour of the end of the competition.

- Prize Giving

The award ceremony will take place just after the end of the final, be sure to stay on the park for the announcement of the final results.

The presence of participants in the awards ceremony is compulsory under penalty of sanction. The participant called who does not show on the podium will not receive his award and prize money.

The top 12 riders will receive the amount corresponding to their result in Euro by Check or Wire Transfer/PayPal within 30 days of the end of the competition.

The registration form has to be filled in online.
For minors, parental permission is required and must be uploaded on the website while registering. Without authorization, on-line registration will not be taken into account.

The registration fee will be directly paid online via card.

Regulations from the [UCI Rules Book](#)

« Registration in the Men Elite and Women Elite categories for the UCI BMX Freestyle World Cup shall be done by pre-registration only. Once the pre-registration deadline has passed, no further entries shall be accepted. »
Part 6bis, Chapter IX : 6bis.9.002

« The organizer is not allowed to accept any entries after the riders' confirmation deadline found in the Technical Guide. The Commissaire appointed to supervise the Competition shall rule in the event of a dispute. Ignorance of the provisions of the Technical Guide or of the competition schedule shall not be admitted as an excuse by any rider or other license holder. »
Part 6bis, Chapter III : 6bis.3.004

« No further entries shall be accepted following the end of riders' confirmation. Likewise, any riders who entered but did not attend riders' confirmation, shall be removed from the list of entries and not allowed to start. »
Part 6bis, Chapter VI : Riders Confirmation, 6bis.3.017

HURRICANE REGULATIONS

Each participant is engaged on their own behalf and those of their employees and agents, and must observe all the provisions of the Technical Guide for the event.

Every participant shall follow the directions of the organization and appointed officials, and any penalties that may be applied.

Ignorance of the provisions of the Technical Guide or the event schedule shall not be admitted as an excuse by any rider or other license holder.

You certify that you have no contraindications (medical or otherwise) to practice a sport in competition.

Also you authorize the intervention of first aid, and if necessary, your transfer to medical services.

You authorize SAS Hurricane and their partners:

- to film and / or photograph you
- to reproduce, exploit and disseminate whatever the medium, or the content produced.
- to use your image and the said product contents whether for commercial purposes and or promotional.

You grant this from this day and for a 10-year free of charge. You undertake not to ask for any remuneration or financial contribution to SAS Hurricane and partners.

UCI REGULATIONS

- UCI BMX Freestyle Regulations

The full text of the version of the UCI Regulations presently in force which is found on www.uci.org shall always apply, save for any specific regulation or special derogation found within this competition guide.

- Licence

A valid cycling license, as defined in Part I of the UCI Regulations will be required and must be presented at riders confirmation to check their identity. An identity card or passport is also mandatory. Once all the terms of the registration are completed, the organization will give riders a wristband allowing them to enter the competition area. It is imperative that all the riders keep their band throughout the event, otherwise the access to the park will be denied. A rider whose license could not be verified and whose status as a non- suspended license holder cannot be established in any other manner may not start and may not figure in the classification of the event. » UCI Rules Book - Part 6bis, Chapter VI : Riders Confirmation, 6bis.3.017
Entry in the competition implies agreement with the event schedule, regulations and all provisions of the Technical Guide.

- Riders eligibility

50 points at the UCI Individual Ranking are required to register. Rankings : www.uci.org

It is important that the 31-12-2019 UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup ranking is used to determine the Top 50 riders who are free to enter even if they do not currently have the 50 UCI points. They are also allowed to skip the Pre Qualification phase. They will need to respect the registration deadline for this.

In case a Park rider does not have 50 or more points his registration will be refused. In case a national federation does not presently have any riders with 50 or more points as of the ranking deadline for any particular event, that federation nevertheless has the right to enter a single rider for the category in question. In this case, it is up to the national federation to choose which rider is entered, if any.

With the following exceptions, every rider entered in a UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup must have 50 or more points in the latest UCI BMX Freestyle Park Individual Ranking that is published prior to the opening of registration.

Exceptions:

- Riders ranked in the top 50 of the final UCI BMX Freestyle Park World Cup ranking of the season prior (2019) may enter if they do not presently have 50 or more points as of the ranking deadline for any particular event in the season following.
- In case a national federation does not presently have any riders with 50 or more points as of the ranking deadline for any particular event, that federation nevertheless has the right to enter a single rider for the category in question.

** Rider needs to have 50 UCI ranking points to his/her name on that day.*

*** This is the date by which a rider in the current UCI Individual ranking (ranking deadline of April 26th, 2022) must register in order to avoid riding in a Pre-Qualification Round.*

If you are already vaccinated, you shall present proof of your vaccination status and a sworn statement certifying the absence of COVID-19 symptoms and of any contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19. A negative PCR or antigen test taken less than 48 hours old is required, except for arrivals from a Member State of the European Union, Andorra, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Monaco, Norway, San Marino, the Holy See or Switzerland.

If you are not vaccinated, you must present the transport company or the border authorities with a certificate of

recovery dated more than eleven days and less than six months, or a negative PCR or antigen test dated less than 48 hours or less than 24 hours prior to departure, depending on your country of departure (departure of first flight in case of connecting flight(s)).

For travellers arriving from a country in the European area (Member State of the European Union, Andorra, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Monaco, Norway, San Marino, the Holy See or Switzerland) a negative PCR or antigen test taken less than 24 hours earlier is required.

All travellers arriving from a green list country must complete a sworn statement certifying that they agree to take a virological or biological screening test for SARS-CoV-2 upon arrival.

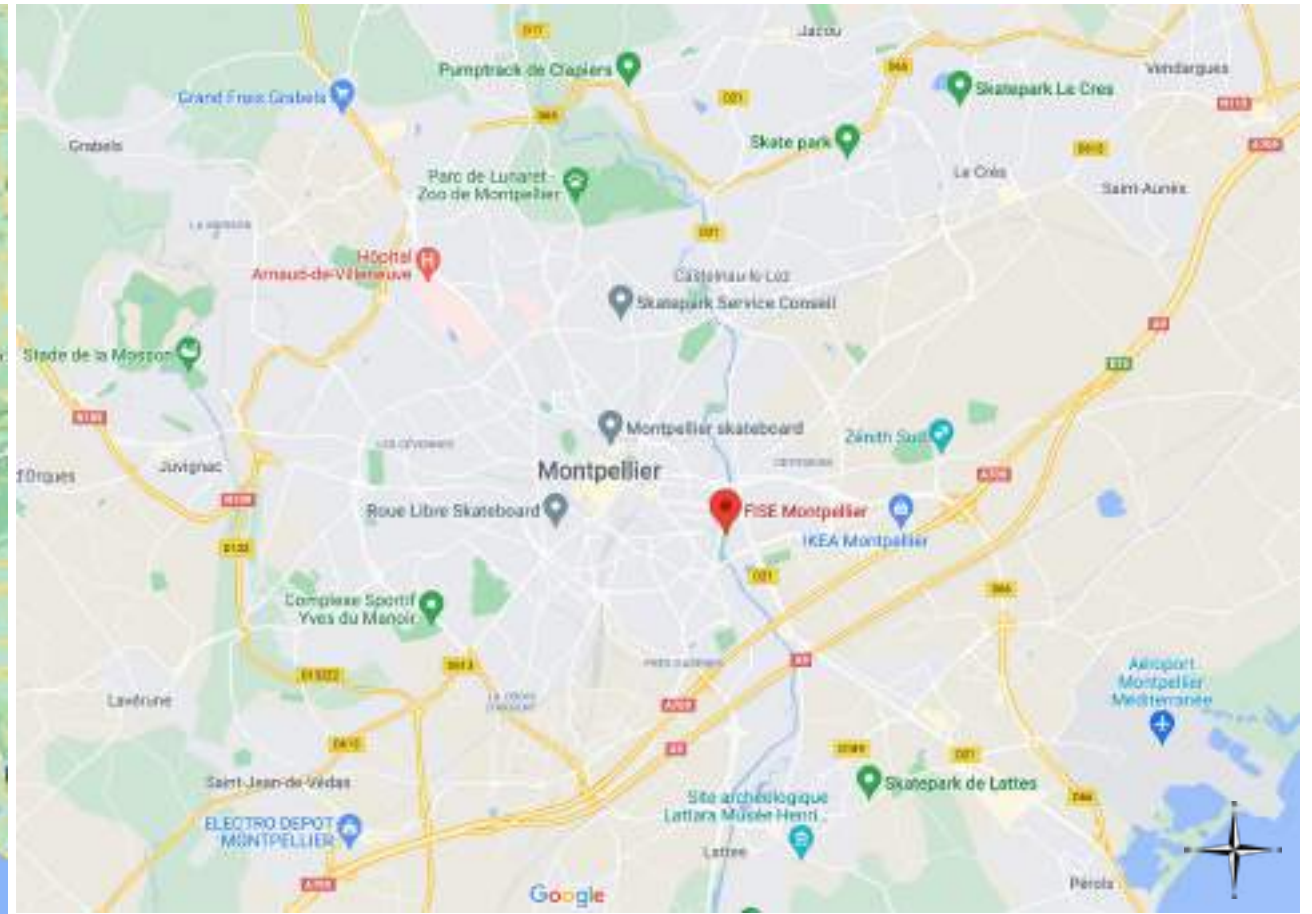
