4. Race regulations

4.1 Rules

Art. 1 ORGANIZATION

Circulation of the 39th EPZ Omloop van Borsele, hereinafter referred to as the "three days stage" is Friday April 19, Saturday April 20 and Sunday April 21 2024 organized by:

The Cycling FOUNDATION COMMITTEE 's Heerenhoek hereinafter referred to as "the organization".

The three days stage is **driven** under the auspices and in accordance with the regulations, decisions and annual detailed rules and instructions of the UCI. The contest is a race category for UCI Nations-Cup Junior Women. The organization is also holder of the game license from the UCI and KNWU and licenses and exemptions from the government.

These is licenses, permits and waivers are available for inspection by the secretary of the organization.

Art. 2 PARTICIPATION

UCI-rule 2.14.050

This three days stage can be attended by international, national, district, club teams and associations. A participating team should consist of minimum 4 and maximum 6 riders belonging to the category: JUNIOR WOMEN. This race is the maximum 5 riders.

Participants are deemed to be aware of:

- the rules, regulations and instructions of the UCI and organization.
- **O** the route.
- O <u>All stages will be driven with transponders.</u>
- All participants will receive transponders by the organization when registration takes place and they have hand over the licenses. (Will be returned after receiving transponders). In case of doping-control we will take care right license will come to the ITA doping-control officer.

The route is identified by means of signs.

The riders, the official route to go, as mentioned in the roadmap. A rider, who has not made official route is not eligible for the prizes of the stage and will, subject to the satisfaction of the contest commissioners proven and accepted by their nature, may not participate.

The organization, the race, the match commissioners and supervisors to be informed if a route change occurs.

Licenses for the start of the 1st stage are shown in the organization to monitor the UCI designated jury and the race numbers available.

Licenses will be kept by organization, however in case of doping-control the organization takes care of license by handing over to ITA-Officer – Chaperone.

The team leaders / soigneurs / mechanics should be in possession of a valid license for the year 2024.

O General individual classification / RED JERSEY(EPZ)

The General Individual Ranking in time is compiled on the basis of time observer (s) scheduled times of each rider in the legs. There will be also taken into account bonuses and time penalties. In case of equal time in the Individual Overall Ranking the hundredths of seconds are recorded during the individual time trials (including the prologue) included in the total time to the riders with an equal time to divorce. The General Ranking Points will be compiled from the number of points in each stage (including time) is granted. The points are as follows earn:

In the event that the points in the Overall Individual Points Ranking no decision will bring the following criteria in order to separate the riders:

- 1. the number of stage wins.
- 2. the number of first places in between prints
- 3. the results in the general individual classification on time

In case of equality, the number of first places decisive.

O General individual young ranking/WHITE JERSEY - Dethon

The General Youth Individual Ranking in time is compiled on the basis of time observer (s) scheduled times of each rider, who was born in **2007** in stages. There will be also taken into account bonuses and time penalties.

In case of equal time in the Individual Overall Ranking the hundredths of seconds are recorded during the individual time trials included in the total time to the riders with an equal time to divorce. New equality or the lack of individual time trials, the total placement figures achieved in the various rounds of the riders from each other. Ultimately, the placement rate, which by the riders was reached during the last leg of the deciding factors.





O Sprint classification / PURPLE JERSEY – Scheldeoord-De Landing.

In the second stage there are two intermediate sprints after crossing first and second round. In the third stage, there are three intermediate sprints.

According 2.6.019 Road Race UCI Version Part:II 01-01-2024.

- First intermediate sprint after 15, 8 km location Camping Scheldeoord Baarland.
- Second intermediate sprint after first Passage big round 41 km
- Third one after the first local round. (second passage finish area) 50,8 km

Each sprint is awarded with 5, 3 and 1 point and 3, 2 and 1 second bonus.

The sprints are announced by signs 1000m, 500m, 250m and the finish line. With a tie in the overall sprint classification, the following criteria,

in the order, used to the league to make:

- 1. The number of wins sprints;
- 2. The best placed rider in the final intermediate sprint;
- 3. General individual classification by time.

O General team classification

The General Team Ranking is calculated based on the sum of the three best times of teams results in Day-ranking of the stages. In the case that no decision will bring the following criteria are used to separate the teams themselves.

- 1. by the number of first places achieved rankings in the day shift.
- 2. by the number of second places gained in the day shift rankings.

Follows again no decision, then the teams will be classified according to the location of the best rider in the general individual classification.

Each team has fewer than three riders taking part in the race is excluded from the General Team Ranking. To qualify for the above rankings, the whole game to be spread.

There are three classifications, each with its own leader jersey. This leader jerseys have a logo, which the advertising of the sponsor is listed. Wearing the leader jerseys during the game, with the exception of the time, is mandatory.

Art. 6 BONUS

At the end of each RIDE IN LINE bonuses are given. These bonuses are included in the General Classification.

Bonuses finish 2nd end 3rd stage:

- 1st place: 10 seconds;
- 2nd place: 6 seconds;
- 3rd place: 4 seconds;

Sprint classification

1st place: 3 seconds 2nd place: 2 seconds 3rd place: 1 second





Art. 7 RACE NUMBERS

The issue of race-numbers images and context takes place at Friday, April 19 2024 from: 12.00 – 14.00 PM in permanence – race headquarters:

"Spek mie Stroop, Marktstraat 16 4453 AJ 's-Heerenhoek".

The race numbers provided by the team leaders to be removed surrender of valid licenses from the participants. The race numbers be visible next to each other on the shirt of the participant to be pin and the plate is clearly visible under the bike to be confirmed.

Art. 8 TIME LIMITS

In consultation with the selection and organization which the riders pass the finish line with a delay greater than 15% of the service time of the winner of further excluded.

The decisions of the contest commissioners will not create a precedent for the next stage. The time in the first stage (time trial) is 33% of the fastest time.

Art. 9 START TIME ORDER

The starting order in the 1^{st} stage (individual time trial) is determined by the organization in consultation with the leadership contest. as 1^{st} does the 5^{th} rider of the last team on the participants, then the 5^{th} rider of the next team etc. Then the 4^{th} , 3^{rd} , 2^{nd} and 1^{st} runner of each team.

The riders start at the minute.

All stages will be driven with transponders.

Art. 10 TRACKING VEHICLES

There is a trailer for each team in the race caravan admitted.

The Dutch follow cars must have their own radio communications. The organization has three NEUTRAL material used cars.

During the time each team for a car to own equipment that the rider follows.

Art. 11 JURY MEETING

The jury meetings take place at Spek mie Stroop Marktstraat te 's-Heerenhoek. The time and place stated in the program-by-match.

Art. 12 TEAMMANAGERS MEETING

The team meeting will take place on Friday, April 19 - 2024, at 14.15 PM at Spek mie Stroop. Any subsequent team meetings are set by the chairman of the jury. (see schedule) The team leaders are required to include in such meetings present.

Art. 13 LINE UP OF THE PARTICIPANTS

The participants, at least 15 minutes before the start of the game as instructed by the race or microfonist on. They also sign the attendance list.

Art. 14 FOLLOWERS CARAVAN

As far as power and purpose of KNWU strip and receiver, the vehicles in the caravan has followers in all rounds except the time on the Levee on Kuijpersdijk.

The ride in the caravan of followers by unofficial persons and / or vehicles is prohibited. They will, after consultation with the leadership contest by the accompanying police to be removed. The broom CAR (last car of the caravan of followers) is identified by a green flag and one for the car to catch.





Art. 15 MEDICAL CARE

After the finish of each stage is a place kept, used exclusively for the cars of the soigneurs / guardians of the participating teams.

Art. 16 TRAFFIC RULES

All participants and officials in the caravan of followers must adhere to the normal rules and traffic regulations. They should as much as possible on the right to drive and the instructions or orders from the police and the leadership race to follow immediately, because otherwise for further participation or coaching can be excluded.

TIME TO THINK WITH ALL THE SAFETY OF YOURSELF AND OTHERS.

Using Polyphonic HORN is strictly prohibited.

All participating vehicles in the caravan must match a valid liability insurance to hold.

Art. 17 RADIO-TOUR K.N.W.U. Radio tour: fréquence Mhz 155.9375

The Dutch follow cars should have their own radio equipment.

Art. 18 HOMAGE

For the proper conduct of the ceremony protocol should be immediately after the end of a stage, except the time trial, on the arrival line for the homage to report:

- The first 3 riders of the stage
- The leader in the general individual classification. (Final classification numbers 1,2 and 3) The leader in the general individual points classification.
- The leader in the general individual classification youth.
- The leader in the intermediate sprint classification.
- After the last stage is also the leading country in the Nations Cup honored

If a rider is leading in several rankings, the leader jersey in the next stage by the next rider listed.

In determining the various rankings, the following order to be considered:

1. Jersey overall – 2. points Jersey Rankings – 3. Jersey youth rankings – 4. Jersey sprint Ranking

Art. 19 EQUIPMENT / CLOTHING / PERSONAL CARE

The participants, with materials and / or clothing to start the race may be excluded from further participation. Wearing a hard shell helmet is compulsory.

Art. 20 LIABILITY

The organization accepts no responsibility for accidents or damage to third parties before, during or after the race is over.

All the race caravan vehicles included a valid WA insurance to have.

Art. 21 DECISIONS

The non-observance of these rules is the participant from the contest or find sanctions against the supervisor. In cases where this Regulation does not provide for deciding on

- game technical issues the race-commissioners.
- organizational issues the organization.

Art. 22 PENALTIES

Penalties are applied in accordance with the standards of the UCI.




At km Point 27.400 there is a railway crossing of tourist train. Note that the normal traffic rules apply and it is possible that train can pass.
